Summary of Content: This listening comprehension workbook is geared towards FLE learners (adults or young adults) who have had at least 80 hours of French studies. It is designed to prepare students for the oral comprehension section of the DELF A1 and A2. It can be used in the classroom setting, as a supplement to another manual, or at home for self-practice. The content is divided into five units on the following themes: « se rencontrer, vivre au quotidien, se loger, faire des achats, se déplacer ». Each unit contains three lessons in a three section format (1. Repérer, 2. Comprendre, 3. Réagir.) designed to help learners recognize, understand and use the French expressions. Lexical and grammatical tools are incorporated into the lessons to consolidate learners' understanding of the material. At the end of each unit, a summary (« bilan ») allows learners to evaluate themselves. The accompanying CD contains the recorded documents. Transcriptions of the oral segments and answer keys to the exercises are included at the end of the manual

Level: Beginners (level 1, 2): A1, A2.

Public: FLE learners, Adults, Young Adults currently studying in or who have completed a level 1 course

Teaching suggestions: Recommended for a beginner class, can be used to complement Connexion 1 in the class setting or for self-practice at home. Also useful for the Conversational class Beginner level 2.
